CTWUG Chairman

The CTWUG Chairman is responsible for the overseeing of the whole CTWUG Group

The chairman ultimately decides on the direction and future prospects and projects of CTWUG.

He is responsible for making the tough decisions and casts the deciding vote in the case of a CTWUG committee vote tie. He is also tasked as being the group's arbitrator in disciplinary hearings.

He also chairs all the group-wide quarterly meetings of CTWUG as well as all the committee meetings.

CTWUG Vice Chairman

The CTWUG Vice Chairman is responsible for helping the chairman with his duties.

The vice chairman is the second-in-command of CTWUG.

He is tasked with helping the chairman run the group and, if requested, can perform the duties and make the decisions of an in absentia chairman.

He is also responsible for driving the CTWUG projects.

CTWUG Treasurer

The CTWUG Treasurer is responsible for looking after the finances of CTWUG.

The CTWUG treasurer handles the groups financial interests, including the bank account, supplier rebates and equipment stock.

He is required to present a financial report at the quarterly group meetings and disburse all money from the group's accounts.

The treasurer also runs the group's finances website.

CTWUG Secretary

The CTWUG Secretary handles the administrative needs of CTWUG.

The CTWUG Secretary handles all the administration of the group, like bookings, documentation, public relations, social media presence and communications.

He is also responsible for overseeing any election processes (like the AGM) as well as taking and distributing agendas and minutes for the CTWUG group meetings.

Technical Officer

The CTWUG Technical Officer handles the technical concerns and running of the network.

The Technical Officer is the person in charge of implementing new systems and running existing systems on the network.

He runs a team of services admins network admins and it is his responsibility to appoint them and manage them.

He is also the principal guardian of all group owned network infrastructure, services and digital information and assets.

AREA CONTACTS
CTWUG First Contacts

The CTWUG First Contacts are a new or existing wuggers' first point of call.

If you are an existing wugger and want to know something or raise any concerns **OR** If you want to know anything or get connected to the network or need help getting in touch with someone on the network, your area's **FIRST CONTACT** is the person you should talk to.

The first contacts are the group the committee will liaise with for any CTWUG Rules changes or bigger decisions that need community input.

Lead Training Officer

The Lead Training Officer is responsible for the education needs of the group.

Education of both wuggers and the public is a priority of CTWUG and as such, the Lead Training Officer is an important role.

Their job is to run and maintain the training needs of the group as deemed needed by the CTWUG committee through CTWUG courses and official training.

They will also run a team of trainers to assist with this goal.

NETWORK ADMINISTRATORS

The Network Administrators are responsible for the overall administration and maintenance of the CTWUG network.

This is primarily for the maintenance of CTWUG owned network links and highsites, but extends to private sites as and when needed.

These users have RADIUS access and are able to login to any OSPF routers.

They report directly to the lead technical officer.

SERVICES ADMINISTRATORS

The Services administrators are responsible for the overall administration and maintenance of the CTWUG services.

Services administrators have access to the group's servers that host critical services – like websites, DNS, WMS and other such services. They are responsible for the upkeep of services.

Services administrators are required to sign an NDA to protect the group's digital information and assets.

They report directly to the lead technical officer.
